***Arundo* is a non-native, invasive and highly flammable weed!**

Threats from *Arundo* include:

- Higher fire frequency and intensity - more dry fuels;
- Modified river hydrology - increased flooding;
- Outcompetes native plants species - reduced wildlife habitat;
- Uses significantly more water than native plants - higher water bills.

Help us get rid of this *dangerous* and *invasive* plant NOW!

Back Country Land Trust, in partnership with the U.S. Forest Service and other local agencies, is offering FREE removal of this noxious weed from your property, and expert advice on replacing it with safer and attractive native plants.
