TRAFFIC CALMING DEVICES

Traffic Calming Devices (speed bumps, speed humps, speed control dips, etc.) which may interfere with emergency apparatus responses shall not be installed on fire access roadways unless they are approved by the Fire Chief.

FIRE CHIEF APPROVAL

Currently, Alpine Fire District does not have written criteria for speed bumps due to the tremendous impact on the suspension of the fire engines and the delayed response times of the ambulance. Therefore, speed bumps are <u>not permitted</u>.

Speed bumps <u>are</u> allowed however, in private parking lots due to the substantial foot traffic. County maintained roads that have speed bumps or humps have prior approval from the County of San Diego Road Design Features. Alpine Fire District does not have jurisdiction over County maintained roads.
