#### A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE ALPINE FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF ONE (1) BME TYPE 6 FIRE ENGINE FROM SOUTH COAST FIRE EQUIPMENT, A DEALERSHIP FOR BOISE MOBILE EQUIPMENT, AT A ONE TIME COST <u>NOT TO EXCEED \$357,402</u>

**WHEREAS**, the Alpine Fire Protection District ("District") approved seeking grant funds from the San Diego River Conservancy for the purchase of a Type 6 Fire Engine; and

**WHEREAS**, the San Diego River Conservancy Board of Directors approved the District's grant application; and

**WHEREAS,** HGACBuy, a government procurement service administered by the Houston-Galveston Area Council of Governments (HGAC), conducted a competitive procurement of fire apparatus and equipment, resulting in a contract with Boise Mobile Equipment for Type 6 Fire Engines; and

**WHEREAS**, as a member of HGACBuy, the District obtained a quote from sales agent South Coast Fire Equipment to acquire a Boise Mobile Equipment "Ponderosa" Type 6 Fire Engine for a one-time payment not to exceed \$357,402; and

**WHEREAS**, staff recommends that the District utilize an HCACBuy procurement of the apparatus to acquire one new Boise Mobile Equipment Type 6 Fire Engine and authorize the Fire Chief to execute a purchase agreement with South Coast Fire Equipment for the apparatus in an amount not to exceed \$357,402.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Board of Directors of the District hereby:

- 1. Authorize the utilization of HCAGBuy Procurement of fire apparatus to acquire one new Boise Mobile Equipment Type 6 "Ponderosa" Fire Engine;
- 2. Authorize the Fire Chief to execute a purchase agreement with sales agent South Coast Fire Equipment to acquire the fire engine for a one-time amount not to exceed \$357,402, in a form acceptable to legal counsel; and
- 3. Authorize the Fire Chief to take any other actions that may be necessary to give effect to the above-listed actions.
