A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE ALPINE FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT ESTABLISHING THE LIMIT FOR APPROPRIATIONS OF PROCEEDS OF TAX SUBJECT TO LIMITATION FOR FISCAL YEAR 2025/2026

WHEREAS, in November 1979, the California electorate did adopt Proposition 4, which added Article XIII B of the California Constitution; and,

WHEREAS, the provisions of the Article require the District to establish maximum appropriation limitations commonly called Gann Limits for public agencies, including fire districts; and,

WHEREAS, the District must establish a Gann Limit for the 2025/2026 fiscal year in accordance with the provisions of Article XIII B and applicable statutory law.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the Alpine Fire Protection District, a public agency in the County of San Diego, California, that the calculated maximum limit applicable to the 2025/2026 appropriations of tax proceeds is \$5,038,341 in accordance with Article XIII B of the Constitution of the State of California.
